FIVE-YEAR GOALS

Protect the Most Important Farmland

Permanently protect **10 priority farms and ranches**.

Support local ag preservation policies.



Scale Up Regenerative Agricultural Practices

Deliver technical assistance on regenerative agriculture to **250 farmers and ranchers** and apply these practices on at least **100,000 acres**.



Support a New Generation of Farmers

Help at least **650 beginning, socially disadvantaged or women farmers** access resources and support broader efforts to ensure farm viability.

Research

Analysis of high quality agricultural land, development risk, and future water resources prioritize on-the ground implementation and local policy priorities.

Technical Tools

Innovative tools quantify the economic and environmental benefits of regenerative agricultural practices.

Outreach

Learning circles, webinars, workshops, and radio shows bring valuable resources in multiple languages to stakeholders such as agricultural service providers, farmers, and landowners.

On-the-Ground Action

Provide support to farmers and ranchers to protect and steward their land and natural resources.
